SUBJECT: Proposed Changes to Licensing Standards

The Department has proposed changes to Part 408, Licensing Standards for Group Day Care Homes. The proposed changes include the following:

Gateways to Opportunity Registry

To increase professionalism and quality of care at group day care homes in Illinois, starting July 1, 2012, the Department will require all new group day care home applicants and assistants, and all currently licensed home care caregivers and assistants, to be registered in the "Gateways to Opportunity Registry." The registry allows child care providers to receive resources and tools to improve the quality and accountability for early care and education.

These amendments also allow the Department to automatically enroll providers into the Tiered Quality Rating and Improvement System administered jointly by the State Board of Education and the Department of Human Services.
