**Non-Intact Family Cases** — The number of open family cases (as of the last day of the reporting period) with at least one child having DCFS legal involvement and placed outside of home.

**Note:** An open Non-Intact Family Case is not counted in caseload computations.

**Child Caseload** — As of the last day of the reporting period, children placed out-of-home and child cases where the child was in placement and has since been returned home, but is open for services.

**Note:** These Child Cases are counted in caseload computations.

**Total Caseload** - The total number of open always intact family, out of home child, and Return Home cases that were open as of the last day of the reporting period.

**Family Case Openings** — The total number of family cases that were opened during the reporting period.

**Child Case Openings** — The total number of child cases that were opened during the reporting period.

**Total Case Openings** — The total number of family and child cases that were opened during the reporting period.

**Family Case Closings** — The total number of family cases that were closed during the reporting period.

# GLOSSARY

DEFINITION OF TERMS

Illinois Department of Children & Family Services  
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**CHILD & FAMILY CASELOAD DATA \*\***

**1 PREVENTIVE SERVICES CASES** — The number of open family cases (as of the last day of the reporting period) receiving either Norman Services assistance or Intact Family Recovery Services for families identified with substance abuse issues in select counties.

**2 ALWAYS INTACT FAMILY CASES.** The number of open family cases (as of the last day of the reporting period) where there are no children in the family placed outside of home of parent and no children have been opened and placed during this family case opening. **NOTE: AN OPEN ALWAYS INTACT FAMILY CASE IS COUNTED IN CASELOAD COMPUTATIONS.**

**3 REUNIFIED INTACT FAMILY CASES.** The number of open family cases (as of the last day of the reporting period) where all children having DCFS legal involvement are now placed at home (in HMP). **NOTE: AN OPEN REUNIFIED INTACT FAMILY CASE IS NOT COUNTED IN CASELOAD COMPUTATIONS.**

**4 NON-INTACT FAMILY CASES.** The number of open family cases (as of the last day of the reporting period) with at least one child having DCFS legal involvement and placed outside of home. **NOTE: AN OPEN NON-INTACT FAMILY CASE IS NOT COUNTED IN CASELOAD COMPUTATIONS.**

**5 CHILD CASELOAD.** As of the last day of the reporting period, children placed out-of home and child cases where the child was in placement and has since been returned home, but is open for services. **NOTE: THESE CHILD CASES ARE COUNTED IN CASELOAD COMPUTATIONS.**

**6 TOTAL CASELOAD.** The total number of open always intact family, out of home child, and Return Home cases that were open as of the last day of the reporting period.

**7 FAMILY CASE OPENINGS.** The total number of family cases that were opened during the reporting period.

**8 CHILD CASE OPENINGS.** The total number of child cases that were opened during the reporting period.

**9 TOTAL CASE OPENINGS.** The total number of family and child cases that were opened during the reporting period.

**10 FAMILY CASE CLOSINGS.** The total family cases that were closed during the reporting period.

**11 CHILD CASE CLOSINGS.** The total number of child cases that were closed during the reporting period.

**12 TOTAL CASE CLOSINGS.** The total number of family and child cases that were closed during the reporting period.

**13 TOTAL FAMILY CASES SERVED.** The total number of family cases that were open at least one day during the reporting period.

**14 TOTAL CHILD CASES SERVED.** The total number of child cases that were open at least one day during the reporting period.

**15 TOTAL CASES SERVED.** The total number of family and child cases that were open at least one day during the reporting period.

**16 YOUTH IN INDEPENDENT LIVING.** The number of open child cases where the child is in an independent living arrangement category (excludes college university studies and armed services populations).

**17 ADOPTION ASSISTANCE.** The number of open child cases where the Department is providing assistance to the adoptive parents after the finalization of an adoption.

**18 DEPARTMENT YOUTH IN CARE.** Those open cases counted in total child caseload plus non-Adoption Assistance cases currently placed in the home of parent.

**19 GUARDIANSHIP CASES -** The number of open child cases where the youth has been placed in Subsidized Guardianship Home (SGH) or Private Guardianship Home (PGH).

**\* Family/child opening and closing data may be duplicative, because either a family or child case might be opened and/or closed more than once during any reporting period.**

1. **DEPARTMENT FOSTER CARE.** The number of open child cases where a Department caseworker serves the child in a non-related foster care living arrangement.
2. **PRIVATE FOSTER CARE.** The number of open child cases where a private agency caseworker serves the child in a non-related foster care living arrangement.
3. **TOTAL FOSTER CARE.** The number of all open child cases where the child is in a non-related foster care living arrangement.
4. **DEPARTMENT RELATIVE CARE.** The number of open child cases where a Department caseworker serves the child in a relative foster care living arrangement.
5. **PRIVATE RELATIVE FOSTER CARE.** The number of open child cases where a private agency caseworker serves the child in a relative foster care living arrangement.
6. **TOTAL RELATIVE FOSTER CARE.** The number of all open child cases where the child is in a relative foster care living arrangement.
7. **INSTITUTIONAL CARE (NON-EMERGENCY).** The number of open child cases where the child is in an institutional care living arrangement. The term institution includes Department of Corrections, Department of Mental Health, Department of Public Health, Department of Rehabilitative Services facilities, Nursing Care Facilities, Private child care facilities, and Department shelters.
8. **HOSPITAL FACILITIES MEDICAL.** HFM is the number of children in a hospital or inpatient medical facility for medical treatment facility. Care in these facilities is often on a short-term basis for treatment of an acute illness or inquiry. (New medical facility code)
9. **HOSPITAL & PSYCHIATRIC FACILITIES.** HFP is the number of children in a psychiatric or inpatient psychiatric care facility for treatment. Care in these facilities is often on a short-term basis for treatment of an acute illness or inquiry.
10. **HOSPITAL & HEALTH FACILITIES.** HHF is the number of children in a hospital or health treatment facility. Care in these facilities is often on a short-term basis for treatment of an acute illness or injury. (Old hospital code)
11. **EMERGENCY SHELTER CARE.** The number of open child cases where the child is in a youth emergency shelter or the Emergency Reception Center.
12. **THERAPEUTIC FOSTER CARE.** TFH is the number of open child cases where the child is in a private agency therapeutic foster home.
13. **FOSTER HOME GUARDIANSHIP.** FHG is the number of open child cases where the child has a permanency commitment by the Foster Parent/Relative Caregiver.
14. **PRIVATE GUARDIANSHIP HOME.** PGH is the number of open child cases where the child has a permanency placement with Private Guardian and the Department has no legal relationship with the child.
15. **GROUP HOME CARE.** The number of open child cases where the child is in a group home living arrangement.
16. **TOTAL SUBSTITUTE CARE.** The number of open child cases where the child is in a non-related foster care home, relative care home, institution, group home, or a hospital/health facility.
17. **DEC:** Deceased
18. **OTH:** Other – Normally a placement type used when the exact details of the placement are not known, and serves as a placeholder until the properly placement is entered.
19. **UAH** – Unauthorized Home of Parent – Child has been placed in Foster Care, but has returned home on their own.
20. **UAP** – Unauthorized Placement – Child has been placed in Foster Care but has gone to another placement on their own.
21. **WCC** – Unauthorized Continuous Contact – Child’s whereabouts are unknown, but they are in contact with the worker.
22. **WUK** – Whereabouts Unknown
23. **ABD** – Abducted
