



LEARN THE SIGNS!

A TRAFFICKED CHILD MIGHT:

- Have an adult control them by speaking for them
- Seem out of place given the time of day or night
- Look disheveled or dressed in clothes that they could not afford to buy
- Show signs of physical abuse such as bruising or red marks
- Not possess any form of identification
- Perform inappropriate work for their age and not be compensated
