How well do you know your partner?

One man's true story:
"I knew this man for 17 years. We grew up together. I had been living with him for five months when he started to behave unlike I was used to. That day I had a gut feeling, maybe I should run home, but I never in a million years thought I'd be here today."
If you feel like something isn't right, investigate! Pay attention to the little things, especially your child's behavior. If it starts to be an abuser they are the person or any other change that cannot be explained, investigate! Even though I am not in harm and I did not hurt him, I still know myself every day because I didn't know. Every day I replay what I could have done to prevent his death. You can always find another job or baby-sitter, but you can never replace your child."
— Linda, age 37

You hold the key to your child's safety. Parents think their child will be safe in their own home. The reality is that many children are abused by their parent's partner every year and some even die.

There are many reasons you might want someone to live with you. You may:

- Be in love;
- Want companionship or someone to talk to;
- Want someone to help you with your child;
- Need a babysitter;
- Need help paying bills; or
- Need help with transportation and a place to live.

Be careful!
Any person you invite into your home will also impact the life of your child. They may be kind and loving to you and still be a danger to your child. If your partner is hurting your child, you may be in danger too, and if your partner is hurting you, he or she may also be hurting your child.

Listen to your child. Watch your child's behavior and reactions. Make sure you know your partner well before you let him or her be alone with your child. If it's safe, ask for help and talk honestly with your:

- Friends;
- Family;
- Spiritual leader;
- Health care provider;
- Family support workers; or
- Anyone you trust.

What is Abuse?
Abuse is when an adult hurts you on purpose. It is done on purpose. It is never okay to be hurt. It is never okay to matter what happened. You deserve to feel safe and loved.

What are the Different Kinds of Abuse?
Physical Abuse means someone hurts your body by hitting, shaking, pushing, choking, or locking you in a room. Sexual Abuse means someone touches you in a way that makes you feel uncomfortable or that you do not want. Emotional Abuse means someone says or does things that make you feel bad about yourself, your appearance, or how you feel. Social Abuse means someone teaches your parents, says they will touch them, or shows pictures of people without them. Private parts are the parts covered by your shorts or underwear. You have the right to decide if something makes you feel uncomfortable, and to tell your teacher.

What Can You Do?
Remember to breathe. You are strong if it is a family member. If it is not a family member, tell an adult you trust. If you tell your teacher or dad, tell a teacher, coach, school nurse, or church person. You can leave for anything you want.

TYPE OF WARRANTS

Authority and Enforcement

JUDICIAL WARRANT

- Issued by a federal judge or magistrate
- May allow for entry to enter private property without consent
- Enforceable by law enforcement, including federal immigration officers (e.g. ICE, CBPI)

ADMINISTRATIVE ("ICE") WARRANT

- Issued by a government agency, such as ICE
- Does NOT allow for a search
- Does NOT permit entry into private property without consent
- Enforceable by federal immigration officers (e.g. ICE, CBPI)






