## **Interpretation**

**Applicable To:** Licensed Day Care Centers

**Policy Citation:** 

407.130(a): Day care centers licensed for more than 50 children shall employ a full-time child care director to be on site in a non-teaching capacity. The director may be on site in a teaching capacity at the following times:

- 1) During the first hour and last hour of a program that operates ten or more hours per day; or
- 2) When attendance falls below 50 children.

407.90(b): The day care center shall employ a qualified child care director to oversee the program and administer day-to-day operations. The child care director shall be responsible for the planning and supervision of the program and activities of the children; orientation to newly employed staff; on-site supervision of all staff; and in-service training totaling a minimum of 15 clock hours per year for each member of the child care staff.

**Question:** 

Can the child care director of a facility that is licensed for more than fifty children perform other duties/jobs that are not specific to the director=s responsibilities, such as; being the cook for the center or oversee, directly or indirectly, the operation of another business?

**Discussion:** 

The licensing rule is to provide standards that dictate a well managed day care facility. The requirement of employing a full time director for centers who are licensed for over 50 children has been established in order to assure that the centers are well managed and meet the requirements of a safe environment for children. Centers who

provide care for more than 50 children warrant the need for a full time child care director based on the time needed to directly supervise the required number of staff, plan activities of the children, and to maintain, hire and train staff.

**Response:** 

When a day care center is licensed for more than 50 children, the child care director shall perform full time director responsibilities without interruption from other duties/jobs. The only acceptable deviation from this is well defined in subsection 407.130(a)(1&2).
