



# Know When to Report, Know How to Support.

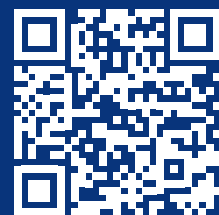
As a mandated reporter,\* you are responsible for reporting suspected abuse or neglect—and can also help support families when a report isn't required.
