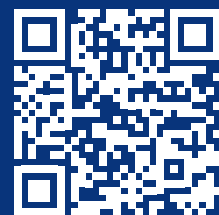
As a mandated reporter,* you are responsible for reporting suspected abuse or neglect—and can also help support families when a report isn't required.
